A local law to Extend Terms of Office for Town Clerk and Town Superintendent of Highways

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the

1. Statutory authority.

This law is adopted pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.

2. Increase in terms of office.

The terms of office of the elected Town Clerk and Town Superintendent of Highways shall be four (4) years. Such four-year terms shall commence as of the first day of January 2012, and shall apply to the person elected to such office at the biennial town election to be held on November 8, 2011, and to those elected thereafter, provided that the proposition submitted pursuant to § 3 below is approved.

3. Mandatory referendum.

This law is adopted subject to a mandatory referendum and shall be submitted for approval of the qualified voters of the Town of Caroline at the biennial town election to be held on November 3, 2009. A proposition shall be included on the ballot at such biennial town election, and the increased terms of office shall not take effect unless such proposition is approved by a majority vote of the qualified voters voting thereon.

4. Supersession of state law.

This law shall supersede Town Law § 24 relating to the terms of office for the Town Clerk and Town Superintendent of Highways of the Town of Caroline.

5. When effective.

This law shall become effective immediately upon being filed in the office of the Secretary of State after approval by the qualified voters. +


