## RESOLUTIONS

\*Resolution \_\_\_\_ of 2024. Scheduling a Public Hearing to Hear Comments Regarding an Easement Agreement and Memorandum of Understanding for Extension of the South Hill Recreation Way

**WHEREAS,** the Town of Caroline (hereinafter "Town") wishes to cooperate with the Towns of Dryden, Danby, and Ithaca to develop an extension of the South Hill Recreation Way from Burns Road to the Tioga County line; and

**WHEREAS**, this proposed trail extension is on a former railbed owned by New York State Electric and Gas (NYSEG); and

**WHEREAS**, a Memorandum of Understanding between the four partner municipalities has been drafted setting forth the respective responsibilities regarding this trail extension; and

**WHEREAS**, NYSEG has offered a Recreational Easement Agreement to the Towns based on a fair market appraisal price of \$36,667, with the Town of Caroline's agreed upon share being \$16,416; and

**WHEREAS**, as a purchase of parkland this is a Type II action under Section 617.5(c)(39) of the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act not requiring environmental review; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town desires to hold a public hearing pursuant to Section 247 of the New York State General Municipal Law regarding acquisition of open spaces; therefore be it

**RESOLVED,** that a public hearing will be held on April 17, 2024, beginning at 7:00 pm by the Town Board of the Town of Caroline to hear comments with respect to the approval of the aforesaid Memorandum of Understanding and Recreational Easement purchase; and further be it

**RESOLVED**, that the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause public notice of said hearing to be given as provided by law.
