## Town of Caroline, Places to See

Route 79--from Caroline/Dryden Town Line (or from Ithaca) to Tioga County Line (both directions); you will go through Besemer (green Besemer sign is where Caroline starts; there's not a sign that says Entering Town of Caroline), past some commercial development, Caroline School, a church, West Slaterville, Slateville Springs (Town Hall/firestation/gas station) and then continue through Caroline to County line.
Brooktondale/Valley Road through the Hamlet of Brooktondale: Post Office, Brookton's Market (perfect place for lunch), Community Center and garden walking trail), Old Fire Hall (part of Community Center)
Central Chapel Road from Brooktondale to Shindagin Hollow (maybe go over Burns Road U-shaped) and come down again onto Central Chapel. Good view from top of Burns Road of Boiceville
Then up Leonard Road, left on Bald Hill School Road, right on Grove School, your're back to Central Chapel.
Continue onto Old 76 Road to Caroline Center and then onto Speedsville
