

Road Excavation and Construction Permit fees

All permits require: description of location and with proposed work staked out on site and other information as indicated below.

<u>Type of Activity</u>	<u>Fee</u>
Installation of Driveway Culvert	\$50*
(note, the Town of Caroline does not supply materials)	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">* No fee, if the applicant certifies that the firm installing the culvert is a pre-approved contractor from the list provided by the Town* The Town will review location and provide notice of diameter of culvert required and any other specifications for its installation.	
Installation of Temporary Access Road	\$100*
<ul style="list-style-type: none">* Fee reduced to \$50 if approved contractor is used	
Boring or tunneling	\$100
Trenching whether parallel or perpendicular to roadway	\$500*
Application must include detailed documentation of materials to be used and installation process	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">* \$100 of Fee is for permit; \$400 is placed in escrow account for fee of services rendered by Town Engineer for review and sign-off of plan documents and inspection of materials and installation process. Any unused funds will be returned to applicant at close out of permit. If insufficient funds are deposited, the Town will notify applicant and detail costs to date and future cost estimate. This amount will need to be paid before a permit will be issued.	
Road surface treatment, repair, expansion or re-construction:	\$2000
Application must include detailed documentation of materials to be used and installation process	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">* \$500 of Fee is for permit; \$1500 is placed in escrow account for fee of services rendered by Town Engineer for review and approval of plan documents and inspection of materials and installation process. Any unused funds will be returned to applicant at close out of permit. If insufficient funds are deposited,	

the Town will notify applicant and detail costs to date and future cost estimate.
This amount will need to be paid before a permit will be issued.

The applicant shall be required to execute and file with the Town a security bond to assure the faithful performance of the terms and conditions of Local Law # 2010 Road Excavation and Construction law. The full amount of the bond or security shall remain in full force and effect throughout the term of this permit. The security bond shall be in the amount approved by the Town Board, but not less than \$50,000.
